

Minnesota Senate District 63 Convention - March 19, 2022 2022 SD63 Resolutions Committee Report

The Senate District 63 Republicans Resolutions Committee reviewed and considered all proposed resolutions submitted at the precinct caucuses on February 1st, 2022. The Resolutions Committee submits this report and seeks a motion to accept and approve this report, including the Resolutions Committee's recommended actions with respect to the caucus-submitted resolutions as follows:

- 1. APPROVE the following proposed resolutions as changes to or amendments of the MN Republican Party "Platform" and for passage to the Congressional District 5 Resolutions Committee for consideration.**

Section 2: Restore and Defend Civil Rights

R1 Would add the language, "We believe that protecting and ensuring election integrity, that MN requires valid, state issued identification."

R2 Would add the language, "We oppose the use of electronic vote casting or tabulation and support the hand count of paper ballots."

R3 Would add the language, "We oppose the use of technology in law enforcement such as drones, speed cameras, AI, or other technologies that assume or assign responsibility for an act to an individual based on the ownership of a vehicle or other non-person."

Section 3: Protect our Health Care

R4 Would add the language, "We oppose the imposition of mandated medical procedures, medications, or devices against the will or consent of the individual."

R5 Would add the language, " We oppose legalization of any practice or procedure to hasten death, including that of physician assisted suicide."

Section 4: Educate Our Children

R6 Would add the language, "We oppose the introduction or use of curricula that promotes division based on immutable characteristics such as race or gender."

Section 5: Strengthen our Families and Communities

R7 Would add the language, “We oppose the legalization of recreational marijuana or other narcotics.”

Section 6: Strengthen The Rule Of Law

R8 Would add the language, “We oppose any actions taken by any branch; Executive, Legislative, or Judicial that constrain the rights of Citizens to freely assemble, worship, speak, keep and bear arms, travel, or lawfully operate a business.

- 2. REJECT the following proposed resolutions as changes to or amendments of the MN Republican Party “Platform” as these proposed resolutions are not consistent with GOP Principles.**

R9 Would “support national legislation to put a price on the extraction of fossil fuels, encourage the development of solar, wind, and nuclear energy, and minimize methane emissions from natural gas and oil production.

-Rejected as industry favoritism, conflict with section one of platform.

R10 Resolution to legalize sports betting.

-Rejected as in direct contravention of Platform, Section 5

- 3. REJECT the following proposed resolutions as changes to or amendments of the MN Republican Party “Platform” as these proposed resolutions are addressed under the current MN Republican Party “Platform” as noted below.**

R11 Resolution that the Constitution of the United States of America, be pledged and carried out by all Elected Officials and Persons of Authority in our Nation under God.

-Rejected as similiar to language existing in Section 2 and Statement of Principles
